

## **By-Laws of Dover Life Guard Club as at: 04<sup>th</sup> May 2009**

### **1 Club Colours**

The colours of the club shall be Black and White.

### **2 Executive Officers**

The Executive Officers of the club shall be the Chairman, General Secretary and both Club Treasurer & Friends of Dover Life Guard Treasurer.

Also, the Committee shall consist of eight other members being:

Membership Secretary,	Poolside / Workforce Co-ordinator,
Life Saving Secretary,	Water Polo Secretary,
Competitions Secretary,	Long Distance/Open Water Secretary,
Swim 21 Co-ordinator,	Welfare Officer.

All Committee members must be not less than 18 years of age though the Committee may allow younger member(s) to attend their meetings without power to vote.

### **3 Club Captains**

Both the Mens & Ladies Club Captains will be elected by a ballot of the Club's swimmers in sufficient time so the Captain's names can be announced at the Club's Annual Prize Ceremony. In the event of a tie between candidates, the Trustees of the Club will vote in the respective Captain.

### **4 Club Championship**

Swimmers can only enter Club Championships if they have been a member of the club for more than two weeks prior to the event which they wish to enter. There will be no exceptions to this by-law.

### **5 Voting Rights.**

Members of the club who receive free membership from the club, as voluntary Helpers, can vote at an AGM providing they have paid the sum of £1 eight weeks prior to the AGM. There will be no exceptions to this by-law.

Vice Presidents have voting rights, Honorary Life Vice Presidents do not have voting rights unless they have paid the sum of £1.00 eight weeks prior to the AGM.

### **6 Photography / Videoing**

The Club membership form includes a declaration that allows swimmers / parents to agree to or opt out of any photography or videoing which may take place as part of club activities. Any videoing which is undertaken by the coaching team as a tool for effective stroke technique training, must be kept under lock and key when stored. Any footage taken must be destroyed within 6 months of being shot.
